

English – Pupils will explore the Shang Dynasty, retrieving and collecting data about China. They explore historical evidence and timelines, plan and write non-chronological reports.

Computing- Pupils will develop the skills of capturing, editing and manipulating video – taking their idea from conception to completion.

History – Pupils will begin again in Summer 1 due to lesson rotation.

Music – Pupils will begin again in Summer 1 due to lesson rotation.

Religious education - Pupils will explore why the Torah is important to Jewish people. Pupils will explore beliefs and make connections between the Torah and Jewish people.

Physical Education - Pupils will be developing their abilities within net and wall games (Badminton) and learning what it takes to be successful.

PSHE & British Values - Pupils will gain an understanding of living in the wider world. Pupils will cover success and achievement, responsibility and independence and courtesy and manners.

Outdoor Education - Pupils will Explore & Play within local coastal regions, rivers and pond areas.

Maths - Pupils will explore proper and improper fractions and mixed numbers. Pupils will compare, convert, add and subtract fractions.

Science - Pupils will gain an understanding of data collection, energy and electricity.

Geography – Children will explore Antarctica. Pupils will gain understanding of lines of latitude and longitude, human and physical features, and who Shackleton is.

Art & Technology – Pupils will gain understanding of Mechanical Systems (Pneumatic toys) Pupils will conduct experiments to gain understanding of how the systems work and will design and create their own pneumatic system.
