

English – Non-Fiction – Does Chocolate Grow on Trees? In this unit, the children explore the Big Question: Does chocolate grow on trees? They read the interactive eBook, finding information, and exploring the layout of explanation texts. They answer the Big Question, planning and writing their own explanation texts based on a model.

Computing - Pupils will begin to explore text, images, and layout features on a document. They will use desktop publishing software and consider careful choices of font size, colour, and type.

History – Pupils will begin again in Summer 1 due to lesson rotation.

Music – Pupils will begin again in Summer 1 due to lesson rotation.

Religious education - Pupils will develop an understanding of Judaism, their festivals and link this to personal reflection.

Physical Education - Pupils will be developing their abilities within net and wall games and learning what it takes to be successful.

PSHE & British Values - Pupils will gain an understanding of hazards, fire safety and ways of having a healthy lifestyle.
