English – Pupils will be focusing on Paper 2 Reading – 20th/21st-century non-fiction and literary non-fiction and are investigating how form can aid in writing a variety of texts.

Careers- Pupils will explore views of others in the workplace and will consider how to appropriately challenging and overcome stereotypical views.

History – Pupils will be investigating the role of the parliament and monarchy under the reign of Charles II.

Geography – Pupils will weather hazards and the associated risks and challenges.

World Views – Pupils will consider perspectives on peace, justice, and reconciliation. Pupils will consider whether war can ever be just.

Physical Education – Pupils will be developing their abilities within net and wall games (Badminton) and learning what it takes to be successful.

PSHE & British Values – Pupils will examine how different groups are treated in the community and consider rights of marginalised groups.

RSE – Pupils will explore feelings that can happen in relationships.

Outdoor Education – Pupils will know the internal engine components of vehicles. Participating in ASDAN animal care and recognising a range of habitats. Pupils will be visiting a local boxing gym and volunteering to support others.

Maths – Students are focusing on shapes, enlargement, rotation, and scale factors.

Science – Pupils are focusing on biology and will discover the differences between animal and plant cells.

Option A- In UPS Pupils will Investigate the benefits of exercise and prioritising health and well-being.

In food pupils are focusing on healthy foods and are practicing a range of healthy dishes.

Option B – Within construction students are focusing on painting using different types of paints. In Land Based Studies Pupils are focusing on habitats and ecosystems.

Option C – Within enterprise pupils will take part in enterprise activities including selling easter hampers.

In PE students are investigating the impact of diet and nutrition on health.
