English – Pupils will explore different genres throughout fiction. Developing their skills of structure, language and presentation when creating their own written pieces.

Computing- Pupils will design graphics using vector graphic editing software. By the end of the unit learners will have produced an illustration, a logo, or some icons using vector graphics.

History – Pupils will begin again in summer 1 due to lesson rotation.

Music - Pupils will begin again in Summer 1 due to lesson rotation.
