

English – Pupils will focus on retrieving and collating information about different styles and explore unusual fashions from contemporary and historical times. They will learn to skim and scan for information, identifying vocabulary that is specific to the topic and using dictionaries to clarify the meanings of words.

Computing – Pupils will develop and use a range of different skills across several pieces of software. Pupils will work between different applications to create a poster and slides on a given theme.

History – Pupils will begin again in Summer 1 due to lesson rotation.

Music – Pupils will begin again in Summer 1 due to lesson rotation.

Religious education - Pupils will explore how the Bible uses different types of text and identify how Christian worship reflect Christian beliefs in Jesus.

Physical Education - Pupils will be developing their abilities within net and wall games (Badminton) and learning what it takes to be successful.

PSHE & British Values - Pupils will examine body image, puberty, the effect of hormones and the uses of each and finally, drugs and alcohol and the effects on the body.

Outdoor Education - Students are continuing their biking journeys by finding pathways, parks, and road destinations to add to their experiences of being in the great outdoors.
