

English – Pupils will continue reading and exploring the play Romeo and Juliet.

Computing – Pupils will discover how professionals create 3D animations using the industry-standard software package, Blender. Sessions will take learners through the basics of modelling, texturing, and animating; outputs will include 3D models and short videos.

History – Pupils will begin again in term 5 due to lesson rotation.

Music – Pupils will begin again in Summer 1 due to lesson rotation.

Religious education – Pupils will learn about The Buddha: how and why do his experiences and teaching have meaning for people today?

Physical Education – Pupils will complete in net games this term such as Volleyball and badminton.

Outdoor Education – Pupils will take part in mountain biking in multiple locations throughout the term.
