

English – Pupils will learn about creative writing and the techniques used. Pupils will create their own fictional story.

Computing – Pupils will identify the input devices used to record sound and output devices needed to listen to it, create layers in their recordings. Pupils will create their own podcast.

History – Pupils will be able to explain how and why the Egyptians were mummified. Pupils will be able to make inferences about Egyptian beliefs using historical sources.

Music – Pupils will learn about ostinatos and the importance of maintaining a steady pulse. They will explore and create a range of sounds to compose their own short rhythm to be used as an ostinato. Children will then practise their ostinatos and use them in a whole class performance.

Religious education – Pupils will explore how Christians show their beliefs about God and the trinity.

Physical Education -

Pupils to learn to develop their attack, defend and shoot skills through invasion sports such as Basketball, Netball and Hockey. Pupils will learn develop their individual skills within the different invasion games.

PSHE & British Values – Pupils will identify actions to keep themselves safe. Pupils will learn what 'digital footprint' means and how to keep safe online as well as recognise fake news. Healthy minds and bodies.

Outdoor Education – They will participate in a variety of target sports, from disc golf, putting, golf and more..

Maths – Pupils will learn about multiplication and division. They will understand what factors are, as well as prime numbers and square numbers. They will learn different techniques to work out multiplications and division sums.

Science - Pupils will be able to distinguish between a solid, liquid and gas. Pupils will understand the water cycle. Pupils will understand the concept and density of liquid, solids and gas.

Geography – Pupils will be able to show where rivers are on different maps. Pupils will identify and locate human and physical features on a map. Pupils will collect data on the features of a local river.

Art & Technology – Pupils create an Egyptian-inspired self-portraits, using the specific proportions and poses typical of Egyptian art. Pupils will apply knowledge of ancient Egyptian art to create final piece inspired by Egyptian tomb paintings.

Modern Foreign Languages – Pupils will explore the French language in particular focussing on the use of adjectives.
