English – Pupils will learn how to write diary entries describing the key events from their viewpoint and report writing about a given event.

Computing - Pupils will learn how to use digital technology to capture and edit images.

History – Pupils will continue to learn about Ancient Greece, including philosophy, democracy, architecture and the Olympic Games.

Music – Pupils will learn how to use their voices and practise their singing skills.

Religious education – Pupils will learn about the story of the Creation in Christianity.

Physical Education – Pupils will gain understanding of attack, defend, shoot through invasion games basketball and netball.

PSHE & British Values - Pupils will gain an understanding of living in the wider world, focussing on relationships, health and wellbeing.

Outdoor Education – Explore & play: The class will develop group play skills at softplay. **Maths -** Pupils will explore working with the four operations (adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing) and will focus on becoming familiar with multiplication tables.

Science - Pupils will investigate the properties of different materials and discuss why certain materials are chosen tom specific purposes.

Geography – Pupils will learn about Greece as a travel destination, identifying the sites of ancient ruins.

Art & Technology – Pupils will learn how to create their own pottery designs and build models of the Trojan Horse from Greek myths.

Modern Foreign Languages – Pupils will further explore the French language, learning about family, pets and feelings.
