

English - Pupils will understand different stories and characters (fiction and non-fiction). Pupils will write a diary in past tense and predict stories taking inference from the front cover and blurbs of books.

Computing – Pupils will explore and understand what audio recording is, how it is achieved and what you how to edit recordings.

History – Pupils will know about where the Ancient Egyptians lived. Pupils will understand the importance of Egyptians Gods and Goddesses. Pupils will use team work to build their own pyramids.

Music – Pupils will identify how pronunciation and tone can effect the way a song is delivered.

Religious education – Pupils will explore how Christians show their beliefs about God and the trinity.

Physical Education - To use different techniques to travel in football. To work as a team and implement skills into invasion games, such as football.

PSHE & British Values – Pupils will identify actions to keep themselves safe. Pupils will look at differences people can have such as allergies and what we can do to help.

Outdoor Education – To understand basic first aid and learn how to deal with first aid scenarios in an outdoor environment.

Maths – Pupils will know how to use their times tables such as 3,6,7,9 to work out real-world problems.

Science - Pupils understand the differing states that matter can come in. Alongside this they will look into how sound is affected and can effect different materials.

Geography – Pupils will be able to identify human and natural features on a map. They will also be able to collect data regarding local rivers.

Art & Technology – Pupils will use colour and shapes to create their own Egyptian artwork. Researching previously discovered work to inform their pieces.

Modern Foreign Languages - Pupils will begin to explore the French language and particularly looking at the French ways of describing clothing.
