English - Pupils will explore different aspects of persuasive advertising: persuasive techniques, repetition, rhetorical questions, direct address. Pupils will learn features of information texts and write their own persuasive letter.

Computing - Pupils will explore networks and protocols and hardware's. Pupils will compare wired to wireless connections and explore how data travels.

History – Pupils will explore medieval times looking at the importance of the church and the reliability of its sources.

Music – Pulse- To play confidently identifying correct pulse and play in regular and irregular timings.

Religious education – To learn about the Genesis, stewardship and to explore the nature of humans and their responsibilities.

Physical Education - To understand skills related to basketball and being able to use them in isolation, and together as a team to outwit an opponent.

PSHE & British Values - Pupils will explore the effect of both legal and illegal drugs. Pupils will also learn about and identify factors of personal healthy and oral hygiene.

Outdoor Education - Pupils will learn how to track and trap animals and understand the laws relating to trapping.

Maths – Place Value & Decimals-Pupils will explore integers, writing, positioning, ordering and rounding. Pupils will compare numbers using symbols and explore place value as decimals.

Science - Energy- Pupils will experiment energy content in foods, describe how energy is transferred, stored and conserved. Pupils will explore fossil fuels and renewable energy sources.

Art & Technology - To develop ideas for 2d and 3d art. To link "Private Peaceful" to express themes visually and convey emotion.

Modern Foreign Languages – To learn new vocabulary, read and decode French football players profiles.

Geography – To understand natural resources, define rocks and the role of soils. To understand the four spheres and the importance of the biosphere for human well-being.
