English – Pupils will evaluate narration styles used within the text and analyse key character and features of the plot.

Computing - Pupils will modify shapes, vectors and lines using graphics software. Pupils will create their own images and develop a project.

History – Pupils will investigate events leading up to the civil war and evaluate key event within the civil war. They will make judgements on who won.

Music – Pupils will research different musicians and performers, and learn how to play simple tunes on a variety of instruments.

Religious education - Pupils will explore ideas of atheism and agnosticism. Pupils will compare attitudes to different core ideas.

Physical Education - Pupils to learn to develop their attack, defend and shoot skills through invasion sports such as Basketball, Netball and Hockey. Pupils will learn develop their individual skills within the different invasion games.

PSHE & British Values - Pupils will gain an understanding of health and wellbeing giving consideration to, risk taking unique personalities and online safety.

Outdoor Education – The pupils will explore a variety of target sports, such as disc golf, putting, golf etc...

Maths - Pupils will explore co-ordinates and experiment with finding the value of x and then plot this.

Science - Pupils will investigate fluids, and examine the arrangement of atoms within fluids. Pupils will explore changes within fluids when there are temperature changes.

Geography – Pupils will examine extreme weather and analyse where and why this takes place around the world.

Art & Technology – Pupils will explore architecture and design, and identify how themes and emotions are conveyed in art.
