English- Pupils will make predictions about a text and infer how characters are feeling. To make predictions about a story using evidence from the text. To identify and use the present tense. To know the difference between fact and opinion.

Careers- Pupils will research different careers. Learn about jobs and occupations. To understand the importance of transferable skills in the United Kingdom.

Science – Pupils to describe speed, use an equation to calculate average speed, be able to draw and interpret distance time graphs.

World Views – Pupils will consider Christian beliefs about God and make links to these beliefs through Bible texts. **Physical Education –** To use different techniques to travel in basketball. To work as a team and implement the skills leant into their games.

PSHE & British Values – To develop understanding of personal health. The use of prescribed drugs. To know the basics of first aid, what to do in an emergency in school or at home.

Duke of Edinburgh – Pupils will investigate volunteering. To identify the issue of which they wish to raise awareness of in the school and research the best way to achieve this.

Maths – Pupils will be able to simplify fractions to their simplest forms. To understand the order of operations. To perform mental calculations and estimation.

Option A- PE – Recap how the muscle and skeletal system work together.
What is the function of the system.
How does the cardiorespiratory system work during exercise.

Food & Cookery/DofE – Food room safety and the risks. Practical cooking methods and taste tests.
