English – Pupils will learn about the key features of narratives and letter writing, as well as practising their phonics and spelling.

Computing - Pupils will learn basic computer and keyboard skills.

History – Pupils will learn about how school was different in the past.

Music – Pupils will learn about pulse and rhythm through a variety of composers and perform their own ostinato performance.

Religious education – Pupils will learn about Judaism and Jewish celebrations.

Physical Education – Pupils will be developing their abilities within Trampolining focusing on different types of jumps, twists and ways to land.

PSHE & British Values - Pupils will gain an understanding of living in the wider world, focussing on relationships, health and wellbeing.

Outdoor Education – Explore & play: The class will be visiting various outdoor locations to explore and play. **Maths -** Pupils will review their knowledge of the four operations (adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing).

Science - Pupils will investigate the properties of plants and what is needed for plants to grow, as well as learning about different habitats in the world.

Geography – Pupils will learn about the seas surrounding the UK, coastal areas of britain and the local coast.
