

**English** - Pupils will explore reading the novel "The Book of Boy". Pupils will identify features of a diary and will write their own diaries in the perspective of characters in the text. Pupils will plan and write non chronological reports.

**Computing** - To explore programming and sequencing. Pupils will understand how programs flow and will design and apply programming constructs to solve problems.

**History** - To explore the rise in Islam and the key features of Islamic civilisation. To explore the first crusade.

**Music** - To understand and perform pentatonic melodies, explore folk music and dynamics.

**Religious education** - To explore prophets in the bible, their role and whether the modern world needs them.

**Physical Education** - Pupils will be developing their abilities within trampolining and creating a sequence focussing on different types of jumps, twists and ways to land.

**PSHE & British Values** -To develop and set personal targets, understand the importance of respect and the importance of self-esteem.

**Outdoor Education** - Pupils will be further developing their bushcraft skills exploring the use of primitive weapons.

**Maths** - Pupils will understand strategies and methods for addition and subtraction for integers and decimals. To solve problems in finance, perimeter and multiplication.

**Science** - To explore hazard symbols, everyday substances and neutralisation. Pupils will explore the dangers of household chemicals.

**Geography** - To explore economy, ecosystems and trade. To understand the four economic activities and how they relate locally and globally.

**Art & Technology** - To explore observational drawing, textures and explore cultural beliefs in art.

**Modern Foreign Languages** - To describe physical appearance, friends and personality in French. To learn verbs and how to use them.
