English – Pupils will study the text Freedom by Catherine Johnson and focus on reporting on key themes ideas and characters

Computing – Students are looking at developing their skills of building html websites. Students will build on their understanding of how to design websites and engage them.

History – Pupils will study the 17th century and observe how people regarded the monarchy and investigate changes to London after the Great Fire of London.

Music – Students are developing their understanding of West African music, focusing on comparing the rhythms and melodies within West African music.

Students are looking at specific instruments used in West African music, such as the Diembe drum

Religious education – Pupils will question the nature of God and the idea of sin.

Physical Education - Pupils will be developing their abilities within Trampolining and creating a sequence focusing on different types of jumps, twists and ways to land.

PSHE & British Values - Pupils will begin to think about their futures and explore a range of career paths.

Outdoor Education – This term pupils will be exploring different environments and honing their navigation skills whilst trekking across them.

Maths - Pupils will begin to solve problems using algebra and will practice using inverse operations

Science - Pupils will look at reproductions of plants before moving on to physical and chemical properties of atoms.

Geography – Pupils will begin to focus on how Asia is being transformed and will investigate human and physical geography of the continent.

Art & Technology – Students will begin to look at the use of colours and the patterns which can be used to create meaning. Students will look at artists and attempt to recreate artwork in a similar style

Modern Foreign Languages – Pupils will continue to learn key vocabulary relating to different types of technology.
