

**English-** Pupils will explore a range of descriptive writing techniques and will be using a thesaurus to make more interesting word choices. Pupils will also be developing their persuasive writing techniques and using these during a debate.

**Careers-** Pupils will research different careers. Develop a further understanding of jobs available in the local area and gain a greater understanding of the salaries

**Science –** Pupils will have the opportunity to explore a range of materials and their properties such as magnetism, density and transparency. Pupils will also learn about the life cycles of both animals and humans.

**World Views –** Pupils will be looking at morality and the posing the questions that relative morality has on society today.

**Physical Education –** Pupils will be developing their abilities within Trampolining focusing on different types of jumps, twists and ways to land. Students will develop further by using the skills learnt and creating sequence for themselves and a partner.

**PSHE & British Values –** Pupils will develop a further develop their understanding of living in the wider world and looking at some of the issue that they may face in society.

**Duke of Edinburgh –** Pupils will undertake the physical element of Duke of Edinburgh. Locating Geocache in the local area, further developing their understanding of map reading

**Maths –** Pupils will be able to develop their understanding of fractions while building new skills in ratio, scaling shapes and problem solving with both.

**Option A- PE –** Students are focusing on different types of levers systems and how they provide an advantage in movement. Students will also go on and explore the plain and axes of movement.
