

**English** – Pupils will continue developing their understanding of transactional non-fiction texts. Pupils will focus on Q6 and Q7 of the GCSE language paper. Pupils will further their analysis with a focus on language techniques

**Careers-** Pupils will develop their understanding of the LMI and how to use it to inform their choices in applying for jobs. Students will look at the average salary in the UK and why the minimum wage exists

**History** – Pupils will examine Elizabethan England and its relationship with Spain. Students are exploring the growth of England's presence in the global world. Students will develop an understanding of why England went to war with Spain and its consequences

**World Views** – Pupils will look at what makes a positive relationship. Pupils will begin to look at the diverse views of relationships within a religious

**Physical Education** – Pupils will be developing their abilities within Trampolining focusing on different types of jumps, twists and ways to land. Students will develop further by using the skills learnt and creating sequence for themselves and a partner.

**PSHE & British Values** – Students will develop an understanding of what hate crime is and look at specific case study examples.
