English – This term, pupils will be considering the purpose of a playscript and learning the key features that a playscript needs before writing their own linked to the key text 'The Explorer'. Pupils will also be developing their retrieval skills to find information about the rainforest to include in their own information text.

Computing – Pupils will be continuing to develop their understanding of digital media by learning about the different types of filming techniques and using these in their own mini productions.

History – Pupils will be expanding on their knowledge of the Ancient Mayan's and will be considering what it took for the Mayan's to survive in the harsh conditions of the rainforest.

Music – Pupils are going to be building on their current understanding of pitch and will be creating music with a consideration of the correct pitch to use.

Religious education – In RE this term, pupils will be learning about the lifestyle of Christians, developing an understanding and compassionate mind-set towards the customs of them.

Physical Education - Pupils will be developing their abilities within net and wall games (Badminton) by learning the concept of game play and understand the basic rules and markings of the court.

Outdoor Education – Pupils will be working on navigational skills and camp craft.

PSHE & British Values – Pupils will be developing their knowledge of their own health and wellbeing by identifying what makes them unique as well as building on their understanding of the changes that occur during puberty.

Maths – Pupils will be carrying out practical investigations to calculate the area and perimeter of a range of shapes in and around the school. Pupils will also be building on their statistical and data knowledge.

STEM – This term, the pupils are being introduced to their new STEM topic of 'the history of transport', where they will have the opportunity to engage in a range of practical activities that focus on how to travel safely such as, how seatbelts work.

Geography – Throughout this term, pupils will be learning about the Alps including: the location of the Alps, how they formed, the weather conditions and what makes them a popular tourist attraction.

Art & Technology – Pupils will learn about the 'Day of the Dead' and will be creating pieces of art that reflect the celebrations traditions and customs.

Modern Foreign Languages – Pupils will be learning the French terminology for the weather including asking what the weather is like. Pupils will also learn the French for the names of different countries and will develop an understanding that French is spoken in many different countries.
