

English – Pupils will be developing their abilities in non-fiction writing, reports and advise and instructing.

Computing – Pupils will be using media- gaining support for a cause.

History – Pupils will be exploring the problems of Medieval Monarchs and the biggest cause of death among monarchs. Pupils will explore the life of queens in England.

Music – Pupils will explore the meaning of song, dynamics and how folk music uses the pentatonic scale.

Religious education – Pupils will explore why Christians believe that Jesus was God on Earth.

Physical Education – Pupils will be developing their abilities within net and wall games (badminton) by learning the concept of game play and understanding the basic rules and markings of the court.

PSHE & British Values – Pupils will be exploring relationships and self-esteem.

Outdoor Education – Pupils will be working on navigational skills and camp craft.

Maths – Pupils will be exploring operations and equations with directed number and addition and subtraction.

Science – Pupils will be exploring current and electricity, creating series and parallel circuits. Pupils will also explore the risks of electricity.

Geography – Pupils will be learning about the elements of weather and climate, types of rainfall and the influence of air pressure on the weather.

Art & Technology – In art, pupils will be exploring mythical creatures, recreating and constructing 3d sculptures. In Technology, pupils will be developing measuring, knife skills and using an oven to bake cakes, pastry and bread.

Careers and life skills – Pupils will be exploring character traits and skills, understanding positive thinking.
