

English – Pupils will be introduced to Shakespeare and will study *The Tempest*. Analysing key themes and meaning within the play.

Computing – Pupils will be introduced to the key concepts of cybersecurity, focusing on how to stay safe and protect themselves in the digital world. They will learn about the importance of secure passwords, identifying and avoiding online threats such as viruses, phishing, and hacking, and the basics of data protection.

History – Pupils will study the transatlantic slave trade and begin to analyse the complexities of the slave trade.

Music – Pupils will explore melodies and basslines and create their own basslines and overlay a melody. Pupils will then begin to listen to and consider how to play blues music.

Religious education – Pupils will investigate Hindu beliefs and traditions and consider how these may impact a Hindu's decision

Physical Education - Pupils will refine their skills in key athletic events, including running, jumping, and throwing, with a focus on technique, fitness, and personal performance. Pupils will work on improving their stamina, strength, and flexibility.

PSHE & British Values - Pupils will begin to consider healthy relationships in the widest sense. They will also focus on tolerance and respect.

Outdoor Education – The pupils will be participating in course fishing at Woodland waters, Ancaster.
