

English – Pupils will look at how different writers use language techniques to portray emotions and tone. Pupils will analyse structure and how this effects literary technique.

Careers- Pupils will develop their understanding of what they would like to do for work experience in term 6. Students will explore how to write personal statements and different features of CVs.
