

English – Pupils will be introduced to 'Dangerous Crossings' pupils will begin to recognise features of dystopian fiction.

Computing – Pupils will look at how binary works and ways coding can interact with developing websites.

History – Pupils will study how Britain ruled its empire and analyse the impact this had on the wider world.

Music – Pupils will explore blues music creating blues lines on a variety of instruments.

Religious education – Pupils will continue investigate Hindu beliefs and traditions and consider how these may impact a Hindu's decision making.

Physical Education - Pupils practice striking and fielding in both cricket and rounders.
