

English- Pupils will explore a range poems, discussing the different structures and formulae to create each. Planning, writing and performing to an audience once created.

Physical Education – Pupils are taking in striking and fielding sports focusing hand eye coordination, hitting the ball into space and being able to bowl a ball using different techniques.

Maths – Pupils look to develop their knowledge 2D and 3D shapes. Looking how to translate and reflect shapes on 4 quadrant grids.

Careers- Pupils will undergo work experience, having a real-world insight into working life.

PSHE & British Values – Pupils will gain an understanding of relationships within society and how certain aspects can have an impact on them. Developing strategies to manage the situations when they arise in their own lives.

GCSE PE- Students to continue a specific training programme, focusing on components of fitness. Throughout the programme, students need to evaluate and review their progress.

Food & Cookery/DofE – Developing their ability to manage the kitchen more effectively. Looking at how to collaborate with each other to cook a complete meal.

Animal care – Pupils are going to create a fundraiser for a local animal charity.

Land Based Studies –Sowing seeds undertrays and looking at harvesting the plants

World Views – Pupils will be looking at Buddhism and how karma impacts those follow the religion.

Duke of Edinburgh – Pupils will begin to learn first aid in the field, developing their physical element of the qualification through cycling.
