English – Pupils will look at creative language techniques and developing their ability to use these techniques within their writing.

Careers- Pupils will develop their understanding of what they would like to do for work experience in term 6. Students will explore how to write personal statements and different features of CVs.

History – Pupils will investigate the development of crime and punishment from the medieval period to the industrial period. Focusing on how crimes have adapted.

World Views – Pupils will analyse how equality has developed within religious ideologies and how this has been applied to different country's ideas on controversial topics **Physical Education –** Pupils will learn about different field sports and develop their own strategies

PSHE & British Values – Students will develop an understanding on relationships with a focus on role models and health.
