

English - Pupils will explore different aspects of poems: language, emotive impact, devices, structure and effect. Pupils will write their own poems and write a diary based on a their interpretation of a poem.

Computing – Pupils will know how to move between applications and search effectively for desired content. Pupils will draw on skills to create PowerPoints, presentations and design their own logos.

History – Pupils will know where the Norman conquest sits in historical timelines. Pupils will explore different sources historians interrogate. Pupils will draw on historical facts to comprehend cause and effect.

Music – Pupils will appraise the work of a classical composer. Pupils will work as a group to explore different dynamics, pitches, textures and tones and create a composition featuring these changes.

Religious education – Pupils will conclude what Christianity, in terms of God being the father, son and holy spirit, means.

Physical Education - Pupils will be looking at the impact of exercise on the body. Students will be focusing on different training methods and how they improve performance in sport.

PSHE & British Values – To understand the importance of resilience the benefits of good mental and physical health including exploring online safety, diet, exercise and the impact of different substances.

Outdoor Education – To understand the fire triangle and different materials that can be used for this.

Maths – Sequences. Pupils will look at linear and non-linear sequences and how data is presented. Pupils will learn about function machines and practice by creating their own drawing on knowledge.

Science - Pupils will compare living things and what it means to be living. Pupils will understand the importance of organs and tissues. Pupils will explore on Egyptian practise and their beliefs in a 'life force' and mummification

Geography – Pupils will explore maps and their own neighbourhood maps. Pupils will explore Ordnance Survey maps. Culminating in collecting Geographical data to be analysed.

Art & Technology – To understand and create art with message and/or meaning. To create an abstract piece with meaning. Pupils will explore and create toys and games both electronic and manual.
