

English – Pupils will explore different traditional tales with a focus on myths and legends of Greece culminating in writing a diary in the perspective of a Greek soldier.

Computing - Pupils will learn about computing systems and networks gaining an understanding of the internet and how websites share information.

History – Pupils will focus on the thematic of Greece and explore how Ancient Greeks lived, identify and compare Greek Gods, and understand Greek philosophers influence on the world.

Music – Pupils will identify the use of body percussion creating musical rhythms and simple tunes.

Religious education - Pupils will look at our community and identify what words are important to them.

Physical Education – In PE, this term students will be focusing on gymnastics. Pupils will explore moving and traveling using their bodies in different ways.

PSHE & British Values - Pupils will gain an understanding of living in the wider world, focussing on using money responsibly.

Outdoor Education - Pupils will Explore & Discover shelter building in different areas of woodland around Lincolnshire

Maths - Pupils will explore working with numbers within the power of 10's as well as exploring addition and subtraction problems into the hundreds

Science - Pupils will look at animals and humans needs to survive before examining how to maintain healthy.

Geography – Pupils will learn how to use maps and locate continents and countries as well as the North and South Poles. Pupils will compare countries and compare weathers.

Art & Technology – Pupils will develop a range of mark making techniques and explore making structures.

Modern Foreign Languages – Pupils will begin to explore the French language and particularly French Greetings.
