

English – This term, Stapleford's thematic is 'Tamarind and the star of Isha'. Pupils will be using VIPERS skills to answer key questions about the text and will be using it to inspire their writing of non-chronological reports, newspaper recounts and book reviews.

Computing – In computing this term, pupils will be learning about different systems and how they work; including learning and understanding the key terms input and output and how these relate to computer systems.

History – In history, pupils will be learning about the settlement of the Anglo Saxons including their way of life, their religion and why they invaded Britain.

Music – For this term, pupils will be developing their understanding of pulse, rhyme and rhythm by listening to a range of genres of music, practising with different instruments and practical activities.

Religious education – Pupils are going to explore the reasons that people worship and why this is important to them as well as beginning to investigate Christianity.

Outdoor Education – In outdoor education this term, pupils will be exploring the forest school and putting their bush craft skills to the test, including how to gather, make and light a fire safely.

PSHE & British Values – This term, Pupils will be learning about what it means to have a healthy lifestyle and what equates to living with healthy habits.

Physical Education - In PE, pupils will focus on invasion games, with a particular emphasis on football. They will develop key skills such as dribbling, passing, shooting, and defending, while learning the importance of teamwork, communication, and spatial awareness during gameplay. Pupils will also explore tactics such as positioning, marking, and creating space to outwit opponents. Through structured drills and small-sided games, they will build confidence, improve coordination, and deepen their understanding of the rules and strategies involved in football and other invasion games.

Maths – Throughout this term, pupils will be developing their understanding of number and place value as well as the four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

STEM – For term 1, pupils will be exploring a range of housing structures and how they differ all around the World. Making comparisons between the materials and identify which are the most reliable.

Geography – Throughout the term, pupils will be learning about how data collection is a key element for finding out information about particular locations as well as exploring different forms of data collection.

Art & Technology – In art, pupils will be developing their understanding of the use of texture within their artwork as well as using print making to create masterpieces.

Modern Foreign Languages – For French, pupils are going to build on their terminology for the human body, as well as descriptive words for this.
