Careers - Pupils will research different careers and learn what skills and qualities they have as individuals. Pupils will identify key qualities of a good leader, take part in team building activities and consider careers that interest them.

**History –** Pupils will learn about the changes within crime and punishment in Britain within the Early Modern and Industrial periods (1500-1900).

**Geography –** Pupils will learn about natural disasters and how they occur including why they are more likely in some areas than others.

**World Views –** Pupils will compare and explain different ways to happiness according to a range of religions.

**Physical Education –** Pupils will take on leader roles within small groups across a range of sporting activities and analysis their performance.

**PSHE & British Values –** To develop understanding of mental health and what we strategies we can use to overcome some of these.
