

English - This term, Stapleford's thematic is 'Tamarind and the star of Isha'. Pupils will be using VIPERS skills to answer key questions about the text and will be using it to inspire their writing of non-chronological reports, newspaper recounts and book

Computing - Pupils will be learning about different ways that technology can be used to communicate including online portals as well as developing their understanding of staying safe when communicating with others online.

History - In History this term, pupils will be focussing on a study for the year 1971 and taking into consideration the lifestyle of people at the time, including social norms and making comparisons to our lives today.

Music - This term, pupils will be learning about how they can use their voices to create a variety of sounds and will be having a go at reaching different pitches and frequencies.

Religious education - Pupils are going to explore the reasons that people worship and why this is important to them as well as making comparisons between different religions.

Physical Education - Pupils will be putting their invasion tactics to the test in Basketball and developing their teamwork, dribbling and shooting skills.

PSHE & British Values - Throughout this term, pupils will be developing their understanding of different relationships and what they could look like, as well as deepening their knowledge of the British Values and applying that to real life situations.

Outdoor Education - In outdoor education this term, pupils will be exploring the forest school and putting their bush craft skills to the test, including how to gather, make and light a fire safely.

Maths - Throughout this term, pupils will be continuing to develop their understanding of multiplication and division and using it in context, as well as naming and identifying the properties of numerous shapes and classifying them.

Science - Pupils this term will be developing their understanding of how the Earth is impacted by global warming as well as identifying different forces including the gravitational pull of the Earth's atmosphere.

Geography - Stapleford class will be looking at how flooding occurs and the long term and short-term effects of flooding and how people's lives have been impacted from serious flooding events.

Art & Technology - In art, pupils will be learning about and creating Rangoli artwork and in technology pupils will be learning about the culture of Diva lamps before designing, creating and evaluating their own.

Modern Foreign Languages - Pupils will be learning the French for key words related to Space exploration and using these in their own sentences.
