

English – Pupils will explore a range of descriptive writing techniques and will be using a thesaurus to make more interesting word choices. Pupils will also be developing their persuasive writing techniques and using these during a debate.

Computing – Pupils will be developing their understanding of digital media by learning about the different types of filming techniques.

History – Pupils will be comparing the Maya Civilisations to the Anglo-Saxons by finding similarities and differences between the two.

Music – Pupils will be focusing on identifying rhythm and pitch in a variety of different compositions and using this in their own compositions.

Religious education – Pupils are going to be recalling their current knowledge on Hinduism and developing their understanding of why Hindu's want to be good.

Physical Education - Pupils will be developing their abilities within Trampolining and creating a sequence focusing on different types of jumps, twists and ways to land.

Outdoor Education – Pupils will be further developing their bushcraft skills exploring the use of primitive tools.

PSHE & British Values – Pupils will be learning about different relationships and identifying what makes a healthy relationship. Pupils will also be developing their understanding of what it means to live in the wider World.

Maths – Pupils will be continuing to develop their knowledge for formal multiplication, addition and subtraction methods as well as furthering their understanding of fractions, percentages and decimals.

Science – Pupils will have the opportunity to explore a range of materials and their properties such as magnetism, density and transparency. Pupils will also learn about the life cycles of both animals and humans.

Geography – This term, pupils will be learning about the different types of Biomes and will be making comparisons between the two. Pupils will also be considering what it would be like to live in these environments.

Art & Technology – Pupils will be developing their expressive drawing skills and creating Mayan inspired pieces of art.

Modern Foreign Languages – Pupils will learn the French terminology for different types of foods and using this to create a shopping list. Pupils will also have the opportunity to taste test a range of French snacks.
