

English – Pupils will continue developing their understanding of transactional non-fiction texts. Pupils will focus on Q6 and Q7 of the GCSE language paper. Pupils will further their analysis with a focus on language techniques

Careers - Pupils will develop their understanding of the LMI and how to use it to inform their choices in applying for jobs. Students will look at the average salary in the UK and why the minimum wage exists

History – Pupils will examine the cold war particularly focussing on the development of tension between USSR and USA

World Views – Pupils will look at what makes a positive relationship. Pupils will begin to look at the diverse views of relationships within a religious

Physical Education – Pupils will be developing their abilities within Trampolining focusing on different types of jumps, twists and ways to land. Students will develop further by using the skills learnt and creating sequence for themselves and a partner.

PSHE & British Values – Students will develop an understanding of what hate crime is and look at specific case study examples.

Duke of Edinburgh – The pupils will continue to work on navigation skills for the expedition section. The pupils will begin to take part in golf for their physical section and begin their volunteering section by creating a campaign within school.

Maths – pupils will learn about bearings and be able to orient themselves correctly. Bearings will be useful in the real world should they ever need to find their way home.

Science – Pupils will understand the elements in the periodic table. Students will learn how to use the periodic table and what the tiles represent. Students will delve into the history of how it was made.

Option A- PE – Students are focusing on different types of levers systems and how they provide an advantage in movement. Students will also go on and explore the plain and axes of movement
