

**English** – Throughout this term, pupils will be reading 'Cloudy With a chance of meatballs' and developing their VIPERS skills by identifying and defining key vocabulary and using this to write their own acrostic poems. Pupils will also be recalling the features of an explanation text in order to write one.

**Computing** – Pupils will continue to learn about animation, including designing and creating their own animations using Scratch. Pupils will then move on to learning about programming and how this is used in everyday life.

**History** – Pupils will be developing their appreciation of new inventions and determination as they learn about the history of flight and 'how we learnt to fly', as well as taking into consideration how this has changed our lives today.

**Music** – This term, pupils will be learning about how the importance of rhythm and pitch in music whilst developing their own sense of rhythm.

**Religious education** – In RE, pupils will be learning to appreciate the different religions and Worldviews that can be found in their communities, developing their tolerance and knowledge of diversity skills.

**Physical Education** – Pupils will be developing their abilities within Trampolining focusing on different types of jumps, twists and ways to land.

**Outdoor Education** – In outdoor education this term, pupils will be exploring the forest school and putting their bush craft skills to the test, including how to gather, make and light a fire safely.

**PSHE & British Values** – Pupils will be learning about positive and negative role models and identifying who these are, as well as developing an understanding about manners and politeness. Pupils will also be considering who cares for them and why it is important to care for others.

**Maths** – In maths this term, pupils will be developing their understanding of multiplication and division as well as recalling and building on previously learnt geometry knowledge, including identifying the names and properties of shapes.

**Science** – This term, pupils are going to be identifying fossil and learning about how they form over a long period of time, this will be followed by learning about soil and understanding the importance it as on our ecosystem.

**Geography** – This term, pupils will be considering where their food comes from and will gain an appreciation of the process food goes through before arriving to their plates.

**Art & Technology** – In art, pupils are going to analyse prehistoric art and use this to inspire their own artwork, developing their mark making and printing skills.

**Modern Foreign Languages** – In French, pupils will be learning the French for different playground games, including asking others to play. Pupils will also be recalling how to say different numbers are their age in French.
