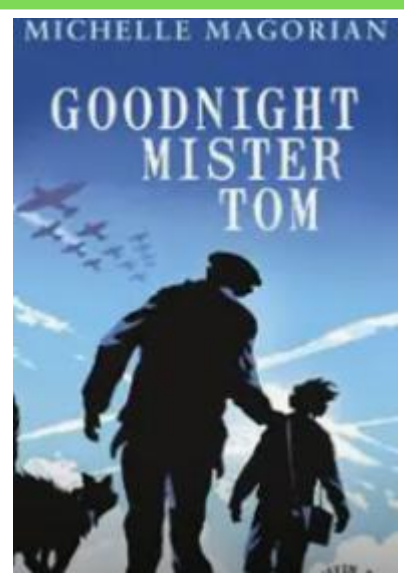

Curiosity & Knowledge

-  Pupils are exploring figurative language, learning how to use similes, metaphors, and personification to make descriptions more vivid and imaginative.
-  Pupils will learn volume, area, perimeter, fractions, and percentages, developing their understanding of how these concepts are used to measure, compare, and solve problems.
-  Pupils will learn about atoms, elements, and compounds, and explored simple methods used for the separation of mixtures
-  This term the pupils are looking at variables and coding

Explore & Make

-  Pupils will learn **pollution** and **population**, learning how human activity affects the environment .
-  Pupils have studied World War II, exploring its key themes of conflict, resilience, loss, and its impact.
-  Pupils will learn artist study, exploring style, techniques, to inspire their own creative ideas.
-  Pupils will learn key French holiday vocabulary about destinations, activities, and travel experiences.
-  Pupils will be following rhythm and beat, learning to keep time and stay in sync with music
-  Pupils have explored how different religions teach peace, understanding the values and practices that promote harmony and kindness
-  Pupils have compared wartime and modern recipes, learning how ingredients, cooking methods.

Health & Me

-  Pupils will explore **stereotyping and characteristics**, learning to identify assumptions about people and understand individual differences
-  Pupils will practice **orienteeing and map reading**, learning to navigate using maps, symbols, and compass skills.
-  Pupils will develop skills in badminton, practicing serving, rallying, and scoring while improving agility and coordination
-  Pupils will learn strategies to manage and resolve conflicts respectfully, understanding different perspectives and problem-solving skills
-  Pupils will explore global issues, such as climate change, poverty, and inequality, and consider how they affect communities and the environment
