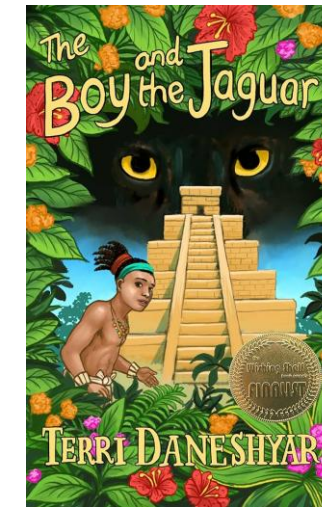

Curiosity & Knowledge

- English:** We will be taking inspiration from our class text to write a Mayan and explorer inspired playscript; we will also be learning about different types of information texts and their purposes as well as creating their own.
- Maths:** Throughout this block, we will be developing our understanding of fractions and putting our measurement and money skills to the test to help us answer a range of real-life related questions.
- Science:** We are going to be finding similarities and differences between animals and humans as well as comparing the life cycles and gestation periods of both.
- Computing:** We will be building on their knowledge of media creation and creating their own informative podcasts.

Explore & Make

- Geography:** We are going to be identifying which countries that the Alps are located and recognise what makes the Alps a popular tourist spot.
- History:** We are going to continue to learn about the Ancient Mayan, building on our knowledge of their cultures, traditions, religion and sports.
- Art & Design:** This block we will be linking out art lessons to South American traditions and learning about the significance of Day of the Dead and how bold colours and patterns are linked, including them in our own Candy Skulls.

- Technology:** Staying in theme with our Southern America topic, we are going to be making and taste testing a range of tamales and tacos, recalling our knowledge of food hygiene and kitchen safety.
