Willingham Weeks 22-26 Provision Map






Text:

Pupils will be studying a range of conflict poetry from 1789 to the present day, exploring how poets from different time periods respond to war, conflict, and its impact on individuals and society. Through these texts, the pupil will develop their understanding of historical context, poetic techniques, and the themes of power, loss, and human experience.






Curiosity & Knowledge

-  **English:** Pupils will be focusing on interpreting poetry and developing inference skills in readiness for exams.
-  **Maths:** Pupils are investigating symmetry in shape and constructing shape using compasses, protractors and rulers.
-  **Science:** Students will study how species and communities interact with each other and their environment. We will then explore the crude oil and hydrocarbons.
-  **Computing:** Pupils are practicing using different software's to produce documents for a range of purposes.

Explore & Make

-  **History:** Pupils are continuing to consolidate their knowledge of the cold war and beginning to look at Russia
